


TCIHRC Partners with The Orchard TCI to Support Vulnerable Families

On July 26, 2024, TCIHRC met with The Orchard TCI, the 2023 NGO of the Year, to strengthen collaboration in addressing critical community needs. This partnership focused on supporting vulnerable families facing barriers to education, healthcare, and legal documentation. By identifying those in need and initiating targeted interventions, the collaboration set a precedent for future NGO partnerships, reinforcing a collective commitment to social equity and support.



TCIHRC Launches New Website to Enhance Accessibility and Transparency

On September 9, 2024, the commission proudly unveiled its independent website, a major milestone in improving public access to human rights resources in the Turks and Caicos Islands. Designed for inclusivity and engagement, the platform allows users to submit complaints, explore the commission's initiatives, stay updated on current events, and connect via social media. With multilingual support, it breaks language barriers, reinforcing the commitment to equitable access for all. This dynamic new tool empowers the community with direct, streamlined access to vital human rights information.

TCIHRC Conducts Critical Detention Facility Reviews

In September 2024, TCIHRC conducted two essential facility and wellness reviews to uphold human rights standards within detention centers. On September 11, the team successfully carried out an inspection at the South Dock Detention Center, overcoming initial access challenges to ensure accountability and compliance. Later, on September 25, a thorough review of the Grand Turk Police Station was conducted alongside the Assistant Superintendent, revealing a pressing need for enhanced human rights training among law enforcement personnel. These reviews reaffirm the Commission's commitment to safeguarding the rights and well-being of detainees and staff.



TCIHRC Engages in Professional Development with DAT Training

On September 20, 2024, TCIHRC participated in an interactive training session led by Desire Adams Training (DAT), focused on strengthening communication, fostering teamwork, and exploring pathways to success. The session encouraged reflection on the Commission's existing strengths while identifying key areas for growth. Through team-building exercises and strategic discussions, participants gained valuable insights to enhance organizational development and effectiveness. This initiative underscores TCIHRC's commitment to continuous improvement and excellence in serving the community.
